NRA CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM WILL APPLY.

CHALLENGES: \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge and will be refunded if the challenge is sustained by the referee. (NRA Rules apply to procedures.)

ADVANCE ENTRY REQUIRED: Please enter before May 14, 2010. Entry fees will be refunded to those who enter and find they cannot compete ONLY IF NOTICE OF CANCELLATION IS RECEIVED BEFORE May 14, 2010 (the date of closing).

TEAM MATCHES: Teams must meet eligibility requirements (NRA Rules).

TEAM MATCHES WILL NOT BE FIRED MATCHES - Scores will be taken from scores fired in the National Match Course for each caliber.

METHOD OF FIRING: This match will be squadded into one relay, with a match limit of thirty competitors. A brief break will be given after each 900.

TEAMS AWARDS: Trophy to the winning team, provided there are three or more team entries.

COMBINING CLASSES: Classes will be combined to provide a minimum of 4 in each class.

This year as in the past we will serve a light luncheon. This luncheon is included in your match entry fee. We again ask your cooperation in MAILING OR PHONING YOUR ENTRY EARLY so that we can plan ahead for the amount of food to be prepared.

General

Information: Competitors will score targets and will be responsible for their own target repair and/or replacement. Bring a low power (1/4 inch staples preferred) stapler for target replacement.

Award

Schedule: A match winner may not also be a class winner in the same match.

Masters will compete for match winner only if there are less than four masters.

No class will be combined with any other class except as indicated including unclassified competitors.

All awards will be paid in NRA award points subject to inventory of points.

For additional place awards, the determination of the number of competitors will be based on:

For match winner, the number of competitors who fired in the 45 caliber matches;
and,

For aggregate matches, the number of competitors who fired the applicable caliber matches.
